With the completion of the new 5000' Runway and Taxiway, the BOCC is poised to bid out the construction of a new 4,500 S.F. Terminal, 11,000 S.F. Maintenance Hangar, and 12,000 S.Y. Apron Facility. The Letters of Interest submitted will not be binding.

It is anticipated the FBO will provide services to the citizens of Citrus County and itinerate customers which may include, but not limited to: customer relations, charter flights, flight instruction, fuel sales, aircraft service and repairs.
